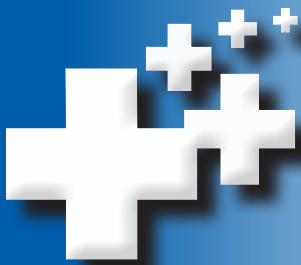

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# Patient Safety Summit 2010 Abstract Guidelines

A primary goal of the Patient Safety Summits is to enable sustainable collaboration in North Texas regarding patient safety & quality issues. We want attendees to leave the meeting with practical information in hand for improving safety and quality at their respective facilities. In order to facilitate this knowledge sharing, participants are asked to submit abstracts describing their organization's experiences implementing safety and quality initiatives.

**Registration fees for participants submitting abstracts and related tools will be reduced (see Registration Form for details). Abstracts do not need to be submitted at the time of registration, but must be received by Aug. 6, 2010. Discounts are allowed for up to 10 attendees per abstract.**

Submitted materials and contact information will be distributed to Summit attendees. Abstracts are requested to be no more than 300 words and in a generic Plan-Do-Study-Act format as noted below. Tools (i.e. sample policies or forms) used as part of this work are also requested for sharing.

1. Contact Information (for individuals wanting further information):
  - Name and title
  - Organization and mailing address
  - Telephone and e-mail address
2. Project's Aim & Purpose: Describe the issue that led you to this work and the overall goal you were trying to achieve.
3. Plan: The team involved, their roles, and the tasks undertaken to implement changes.
4. Do and Study: Describe what actually happened when the initiative was implemented, including measured results and lessons learned.
5. Act: Describe any planned next steps.
